Membership TERMS & CONDITIONS

Membership terms and conditions that apply to DeepBrainReorienting Ltd. If you have any questions, please e-mail us: admin@deepbrainreorienting.com

1. GENERAL MEMBERSHIP

1.1. DBR General Membership is an agreement between DeepBrainReorienting Ltd, company registration number SC778207 (hereafter "DBR") and you personally (subsequently "Member").

1.2. Only individuals over 18 who have trained to Level 1 in DBR are eligible for membership in DBR. We do not have a membership category for organisations, though individuals over 18 who practise DBR within statutory, voluntary or academic sectors are eligible for individual membership.

1.3. DBR may amend the membership content (membership rules, benefits etc.). DBR will inform you of such changes via our website or by e-mail.

1.4. The Member can terminate the membership by cancelling their subscription. Benefits will be retained until the date the membership was due for renewal.

1.5. The membership starts on the day the first payment is collected and will be automatically renewed after one year. A reminder of the payment will be sent via email 3 days in advance.

1.6 Members will be able to apply discount coupons for workshops and courses (not DBR Core Levels 1-3 Trainings) by logging into their DBR account before booking.

1.7. Discounted fees on events offered to members are not allowed to be sold nor transferred to third parties, and we reserve the right to change the fee associated with any registrations for events if this happens.

1.8. In the event of any breach that has been upheld, of the [DBR Professional Code of Good Standing](#), DBR has the right to terminate the membership immediately. Breach can consist of disrespectful or unsuitable behaviour towards DBR or its members and stakeholders, illegal conduct or actions generally regarded as immoral or unethical or violating the Terms and Conditions.

1.9. Any dispute regarding the content of the Terms and Conditions will be resolved according to English Law with the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of England and Wales and settled in an English or Welsh Court of Law. DBR is not responsible for events arising due to legal enactments, government decisions, emergencies, strikes, blockades, boycotts, lockouts or other similar circumstances.

1.10. DBR reserves the right to cancel DBR memberships with six months' notice to the members. Such information may be sent via e-mail or published on the DBR website. DBR is not responsible for any loss such termination may imply for the individual member.

2. MEMBERSHIP LEVELS

2.1. Membership of DBR will have three levels:

General Members – for those who have trained in DBR (from level 1 onwards)

Approved DBR Practitioner Membership – for those who have been granted Approved DBR-P status

Approved DBR Consultant Membership – for those who have been granted Approved DBR-C status

2.2. During the first few years of the Approval Process (started 2025) all members will be first signed up as a General Member.

3. BENEFITS

3.1. Current Member benefits are listed on the DBR website: deepbrainreorienting.com

4. PERSONAL INFORMATION

4.1. DBR is responsible for processing the personal information the Member agrees to provide.

4.2. The personal data provided by the Member when registering will be used by DBR to process and administer the membership and will be subject to GDPR requirements.

4.3. By signing up for a membership, the Member accepts the below-stated process of personal data, and receives communication from DBR via regular mailshot or email, and any linked social media accounts that the Member signs up to.

4.4. The Member accepts that DBR, subcontractors and companies process the Member's data according to the terms and conditions of the membership, stated below:

- To update personal data
- To provide and develop business services and product
- To improve the quality of the DBR membership experience and digital services
- To individualise DBR communication with the members
- To provide DBR updates via mailshot and email
- To evaluate tools and analyse data.

4.5. For the above purposes, DBR may collect and use personal data as intended below:

- Information provided by the member when registering and purchasing services or products from DBR, events, workshops, webinars, conferences and the like.

4.6. We save account information regarding purchases.

4.7. The Member can send a request to see the personal data that DBR are processing.

4.8. The Member is entitled to request that DBR either amend, correct or erase the Member's personal data. The request must be sent in writing to Deepbrainreorienting Ltd at admin@deepbrainreorienting.com

4.9. Information about any membership account is only disclosed to the Member or a person with the Member's written and signed power of attorney.

4.10. The Member may unsubscribe from direct marketing and newsletters, mailshots at any time by using the 'unsubscribe' button on the mailshots.
